Materials

1 pair

**Botties Soles Basic Edition
including felt insoles
and thread for „Round 0“**

EU sizes: 37/38, 39/40, 41/42

US sizes: 6.5/7.5, 8.5/9.5, 10.5/11.5

UK sizes: 4.5/5.5, 6.5/7.5, 8.5/9.5

1 ball

„Go for Faux‘ by Lion Brand Yarns

100% Polyester fur yarn

Weight of ball: 100 g / 3.5 oz

Length of ball: 60 m / 65 yards

darning or wool needle

dull, with large eyelet

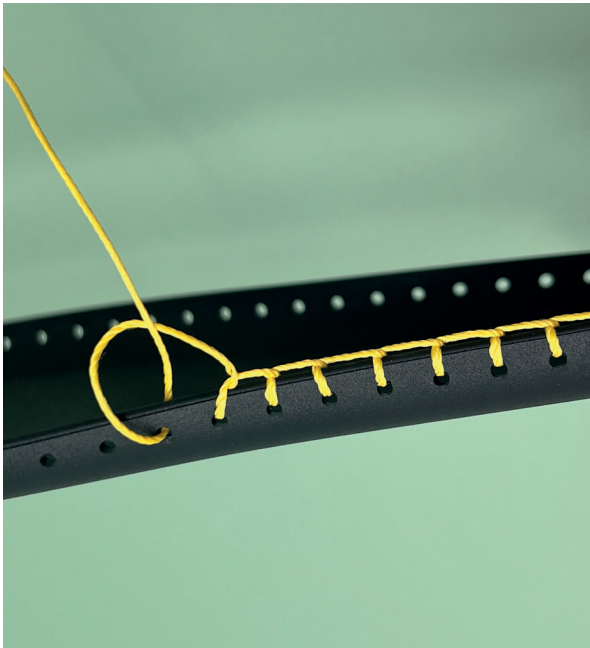
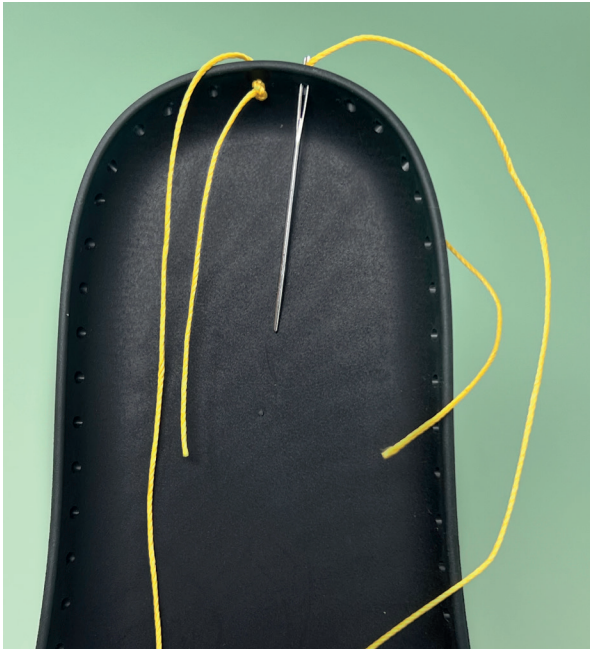
Hook

6 mm

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Round 0



Take the wool needle and thread for round 0. Divide the latter (about 2.5 meters / 2.7 yards). Take thread single. Hem the sole edge with the blanket stitch.



Upper shoe

We use UK term
„double crochet“
= single crochet
(US term)

Start with the fur yarn in the second stitch right from the middle of the toe (seen from the front, heel facing away from the body). Crochet the first row with 5 double crochet stitches. Then crochet back with 5 double crochet stitches without a turning chain stitch and at the end of the row crochet a 6th double crochet stitch into the next free stitch of round 0. Turn the row again without a turning chain stitch and crochet back with 6 double crochet stitches. Finally, an additional 7th stitch is crocheted into the next free stitch of round 0. Continue this principle.

Important: Since you can hardly see the stitches in the fluffy fur yarn, it is difficult to count them. Therefore, this slipper must be worked by eye and feel. We recommend slipping into the slipper every 2-3 rows to adjust the width to your own foot and feeling.

This is done by increases or decreases:

- **Increases** are worked in the middle of a row, by crocheting one stitch more.
- **Decreases** are worked in the middle of a row by crocheting two stitches together. As an alternative you may skip one stitch if you find it easier with the fur yarn.

Continue in this way until the desired height is reached. In between, keep checking the fit of the slippers on your own foot.

Once the desired height is reached, the complete slip-in hole (also at the heel) is crocheted twice all around in double crochet stitches and the thread is sewn at the end. Now insert the insole and sew on logo labels – done!
