


Crochet pattern by "Landherzen" for Botties® Basic Edition

C103 Jersey Bottielettes







Material


1 pair Botties soles Basic Edition including felt insole and yarn for Round Zero Sizes: 37/38, 39/40, 41/42

1 ball Cotton Jersey yarn from Schachenmayr Weight per ball: 100g Length per ball: 74m

Crochet hook 3 mm with metal tip for edging the 1st sole round

crochet hook 4 mm for crocheting the 2nd sole round and the foot strap

Edging of the BOTTIES sole

1st round: insert a 3.0 mm crochet hook into the center back hole of the sole and crochet two chain stitches, then crochet a double crochet in each hole of the sole, end the round with a slip stitch (insert into the 2nd chain stitch).

2nd round: crochet a chain stitch with a 4.0 hook and then crochet a slip stitch in each double crochet of the previous round. Cut the thread at the end of the round and pull it through the loop.

Foot strap

To find the right position of the strap, I recommend slipping into an existing pair of mules and noting where the foot strap sits best and how wide it should be. Then mark the position of the strap on both soles (e.g. with a stitch marker or safety pin).

The foot strap is crocheted with rows of double crochet and crocheted onto the previous chain stitches around the sole.

Start on the outer side of the sole and insert between the slip stitch and double crochet. Start with 2 chain stitches and crochet as many double crochets as necessary. On my Bottielette (shoe size 37/38), the strap is approx. 7 cm wide and has a total of 10 double crochets (2 chain stitches + 9 double crochets). My foot strap is approx. 10 cm high and has 8 rows of double crochets.

Before crocheting the foot strap on the opposite side, try on the mule to see if it fits and sew on the starting thread. Sew on the BOTTIES logo if you like.

I crochet the foot strap to the sole with single crochet stitches (as many single crochet stitches as the number of double crochets in the foot strap) between slip stitch and double crochet.

Cut the thread and sew. To finish, I crocheted single crochet stitches around the front edge of the foot strap -

always insert between the rows of double crochet stitches of the foot strap (i.e. 8 single crochet stitches in 8 rows of double crochet stitches), so that the front of the foot strap tightens a little and the foot has a better grip. Sew the thread, insert the felt sole, done!
