MATERIAL REQUIRED

1. A pair of Botties basic
2. Pattern
3. Felt fabric for the upper(yellow & off-white)
4. Faux leather
5. Suede or other soft fabric for the lining
6. scissors
7. Fusing
8. Thread
9. Strong Adhesive.
10. Punch Plier

INSTRUCTIONS

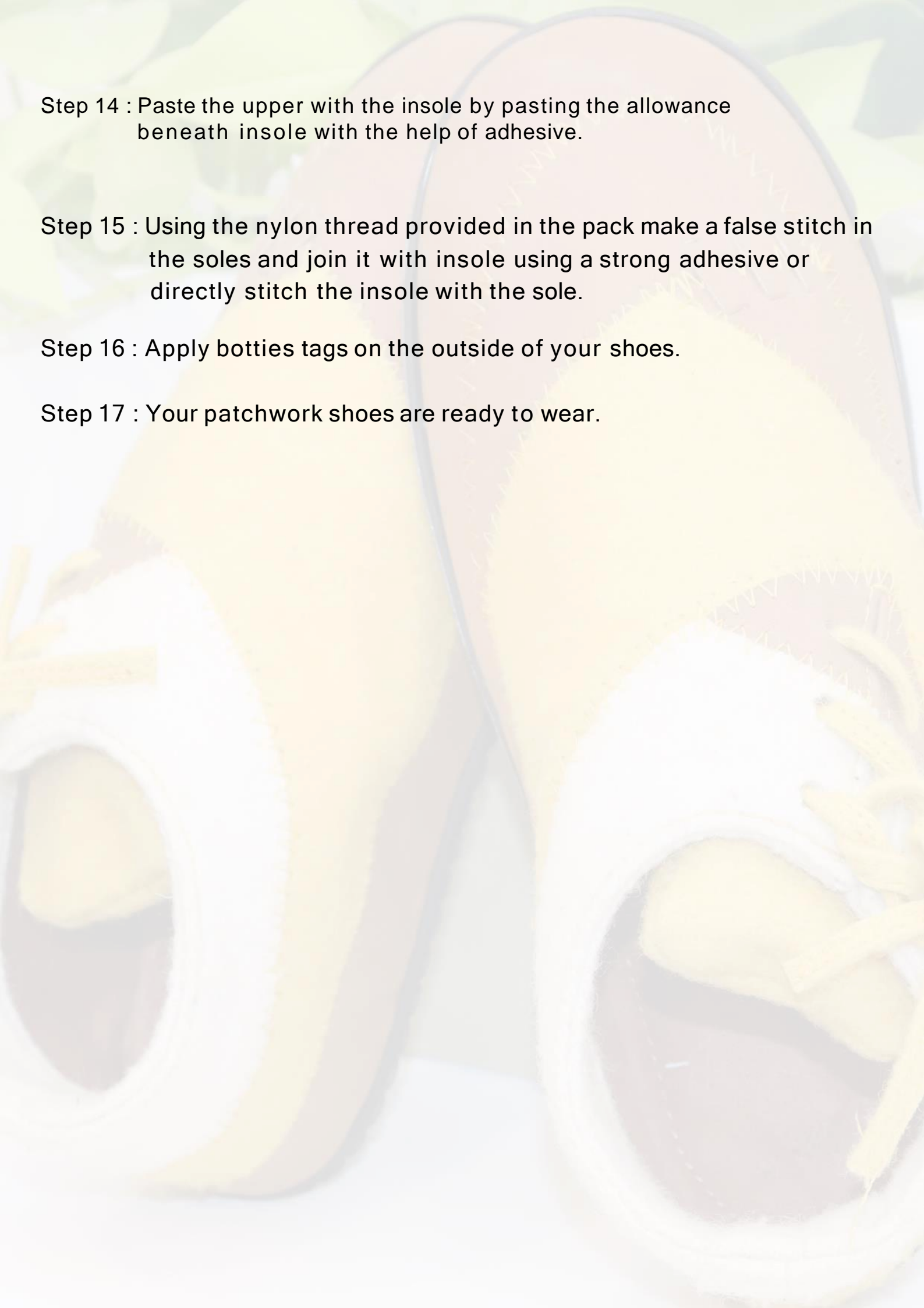
- Step 1 : Print the pattern For both upper & lining according to your shoe size by clicking the link provided.
- Step 2 : Trace & cut pattern no.1,2,3,5 & 6 on faux leather, pattern no. 4 on yellow felt fabric, pattern no. 7,8 on off white felt fabric. Don't forget the stitching and pasting allowances while tracing.
- Step 3 : Cut all the upper parts carefully.
- Step 4 : Paste fusing in all the upper panels for reinforcement.
- Step 5 : Stitch all the panels together as directed in the pattern.
- Step 6 : Make cuts on the toe part and pass three faux leather strands through it (paste the extra allowance beneath).
- Step 7 : Give zigzag top stich at the joining of each panel.
- Step 8 : Trace & cut the lining panels out of contrasting suede fabric.
- Step 9 : Stitch all the lining panels together.
- Step 10 : Stitch the lining and upper together from the neck using stich and flip technique.
- Step 11 : Make eyelets for lacing using punch plier.
- Step 12 : Trace & cut tongue panels along with the allowances out of yellow felt fabric.
- Step 12 : Stitch the tongue panels and attach it beneath the lining as per the placement shown in pattern sheet.
- Step 13 : Cover the botties insole with the lining fabric using strong adhesive.

Step 14 : Paste the upper with the insole by pasting the allowance beneath insole with the help of adhesive.

Step 15 : Using the nylon thread provided in the pack make a false stitch in the soles and join it with insole using a strong adhesive or directly stitch the insole with the sole.

Step 16 : Apply botties tags on the outside of your shoes.

Step 17 : Your patchwork shoes are ready to wear.



TIPS & TRICKS

- Join all the panels by aligning the centers.
- Join all the panels using all-pins and then stitch it all together to avoid ruckus.
