# MATERIAL REQUIRED

1. A pack of Botties basic
2. Pattern, Suede Leather & Jacquard Fabric for upper.
3. Suede lining fabric.
4. Scissors
5. Thread
6. Strong
7. Adhesive

# INSTRUCTIONS

- Step 1 : Print the patterns for both the upper and lining according to your shoe size by clicking the provided link.
- Step 2 : Trace the upper onto the suede leather and cut it out carefully.
- Step 3 : Trace the back panel on jacquard fabric
- Step 4 : Stitch the front and back panel together from the sides as directed in the pattern.
- Step 5 : Cut the lining panels out of suede fabric and join them as directed in the pattern.
- Step 6 : Join the upper with the lining (from the wrong side) using the stitch and flip technique.
- Step 7 : Cover the insole with suede fabric for added comfort.
- Step 8 : Adhere the upper to the insole using a strong adhesive.
- Step 9 : Use the provided nylon thread to create a false stitch on the sole and attach it to the insole using a strong adhesive or directly stitch the insole to the sole.
- Step 10 : Apply booties tags on the outside of your shoes
- Step 11 : Your slip-on ankle boots are now ready to wear

# TIPS & TRICKS

- Mark the centers on each panel while tracing.
- Use fabric fusing to strengthen the boots.
